



Epsom Cavy Club Rules

Epsom Cavy Club hereafter known as "The Club".

The Club reserves the right to close entries early if the number of entries dictates, due to the number of show pens or maximum capacity of the hall being reached.

All entries must be paid for even if you are unable to attend the show.

The Club reserves the right to refuse entries from anyone owing money from a previous show.

The Club reserves the right to amend judges where necessary.

NO animals except for cavies are allowed in the show hall.

NO shavings or loose bedding is allowed in the show hall or carpeted entrance lobby.

NO preparation of pigs in the carpeted entrance lobby or the small storage room is allowed.

Cavies to be penned by the stated penning time. Anyone arriving late will be allowed to pen cavies ONLY at Club Secretary's discretion.

All carriers to be stored in a safe place or as directed. The Club Secretary will remove any boxes causing an obstruction or hazard.

Exhibitors are not allowed to block fire exits with either boxes or chairs.

The Club encourages youngsters, BUT parents must take responsibility to supervise them at all times. Unsupervised or disruptive children will be asked to leave the hall.

The Club abides by Southern Cavy Club sale pens rules.

NO boxing up until ALL judging has been completed, including pets. The Club Secretary will inform exhibitors when boxing up is allowed.

Please take ALL rubbish and bedding home with you.

Please leave the toilets, as you would wish to find them!
